- All entrants & vendors will be assigned a space in the Pinellas Pioneer Settlement
- Entrants & vendors who require electricity must request so on registration form (where indicated) and will provide their own 100ft extension cord
- 10' x 10' tents are strongly encouraged for non-pole barn entrants due to tree debris.
- Registration table is located at the entrance of Pinellas Pioneer Settlement Pedestrian Gate. Registration and set-up begin at 9:00 am.

ADMISSION

Entrants & vendors will receive two (2) wristbands each for chili tasting
Additional wristbands will be available for purchase at regular price (\$5.00)

ENTRY CATEGORIES

Beef Chili
Other Meat Chili
Vegetarian Chili

Judging by the tasters will be tallied for each category; there will be a first and second place winner for each category of chili.

REQUIREMENTS

Minimum of 2 gallons of chili (would provide up to 128 people judging of your chili, so you can bring more.)

Full Ingredient List (mandatory due to allergies) and optional recipe must be submitted to Pinellas Pioneer Settlement by January 9th, 2011.

If you do not wish your recipe to be part of the recipe book do not submit a recipe.

What Pinellas Pioneer Settlement provides:

- 10 x 10 space in field or smaller area under pole barn
- 2 oz. tasting cups
- Spoons (for chili tasters)
- Napkins (for chili tasters)
- Electricity (**must be indicated on registration form**)

What you provide:

- Tent/Canopy for non-pole barn entrants
- Table and Chairs
- Tablecloth
- Booth Decorations-Many teams tie their chili name, clothes and decorations all together. This is not mandatory, but a lot of fun.
- Trash can/bag
- 100 ft extension cord (if you require electricity)
- Ladle or spoon to dish out your chili (remember, we are providing 2 oz cups, so the smaller the ladle/spoon that you use, the easier to fill the cups-and less spilling)
- Clean up materials

Don't forget any of the special sides that make YOUR chili PERFECT! i.e.:

- Sour cream
- Hot sauce
- Shredded cheese
- Chopped Onions
- Rice
- Spaghetti
- Corn bread
- Tortilla Chips

PLEASE NOTE: Chili vendors must make sure that participants have a wristband if they are requesting chili. PLEASE DO NOT give anyone chili who does not have a wristband. Thank you!

Non powered space is mandatory for all Portable Gas cooking. This includes a designated 10ft x 10ft space. You will provide tables, chairs, your cooking device, etc. A tent is suggested due to tree debris.

Powered space is for crock pot style entries. It is limited to first 14 entries for Powered Space. You will be under the cover of a pole barn. It is suggested you provide a 4 to 6 foot table due to space. You may have one in front and behind you. A 25 foot extension cord will be necessary along with your crock pot, chairs, etc.

Non Powered space with access to power. This includes a designated 10ft x 10ft space. You will provide a 100 foot extension cord, tables, chairs, your electric cooking device, etc. A tent is suggested due to tree debris.
